- Membership: Freshman 50% / Sophomore 20% / Juniors 11% / Seniors 17%
- Membership dollars not provided

- Financial Update \$14,300 beginning cash
- Additions: \$635 donations and \$150 club fees Total income \$785
- Expenses: Each teacher receives \$250 for classroom per year Virma (CS) \$196, \$173 for outreach refreshments and judge's breakfast; frisbees were given to all 2020 seniors w/ CREST logo (graduation drive through); President's Volunteer Awards \$691; Annual PTO fee \$50 Total expenses \$1,110
- Ending cash on hand \$14,000
- Transferred cash (approximately \$1,400) from paypal to bank account and will be in October reconciliation
