#### Microbiology - Michelle Landreville

Seniors are working on Capstone projects by refining topics, developing problem statements, and research questions. Students have conducted 7 different bacterial assays on 10 different species.

#### Honors STEM Collaborative:

Students have been placed into their project teams after completing a 6 day safety rotation. Students spent 2 days learning biological and chemical safety with Mrs. Landreville or Ms. Cherry, 2 days in the engineering lab with Mrs. Setton learning about shop and equipment safety, and 2 days in the comp sci room with Mr. Troxel learning digital safety.

HSC students are choosing their projects.
