

## **CREST Coordinator's Report DEC 2022**

Congratulations on approaching the finish line of your first semester of the 2022-23 school year. Freshmen parents, I am sure your kids have been very busy and a "bit" stressed while completing their STEM Collaborative projects. Most of the projects seem reasonable, some of them work, but all were the result of lots of hard work, research, team building, and full of new knowledge and skills. I am very proud of the 9th grade students as they rose to the challenge. In addition to the freshman work, projects from 12th grade Bioscience and Engineering, 11th grade Computer Science projects and Engineering house designs, 10th-grade Bioscience disease research projects and Engineering PLTW POE competition projects were also completed. The CREST Fall Project Symposium wa held Dec 7 and 8, featuring over 225 projects over the two nights.

Just a quick update on recruiting...it's going very well. **We are full in Bioscience and 75% full in both Computer Science and Engineering**. Applications are up 150% of last year at this time. 138 students have been accepted as of today with 33 on a waitlist.

At the AP Capstone Information Night, January 9th, ninth-grade students and parents will be able to hear from current students and teachers about this diploma program from College Board based on two, yearlong AP courses: AP Seminar and AP Research.

In January, students will be meeting with their counselors to select their courses for next fall.
